In this sought after annual competition, coding enthusiasts put their skills to the test by working their way through a series of tasks to earn a spot at the finals. They will test their programming limits for a chance to win the championship title and amazing prizes.

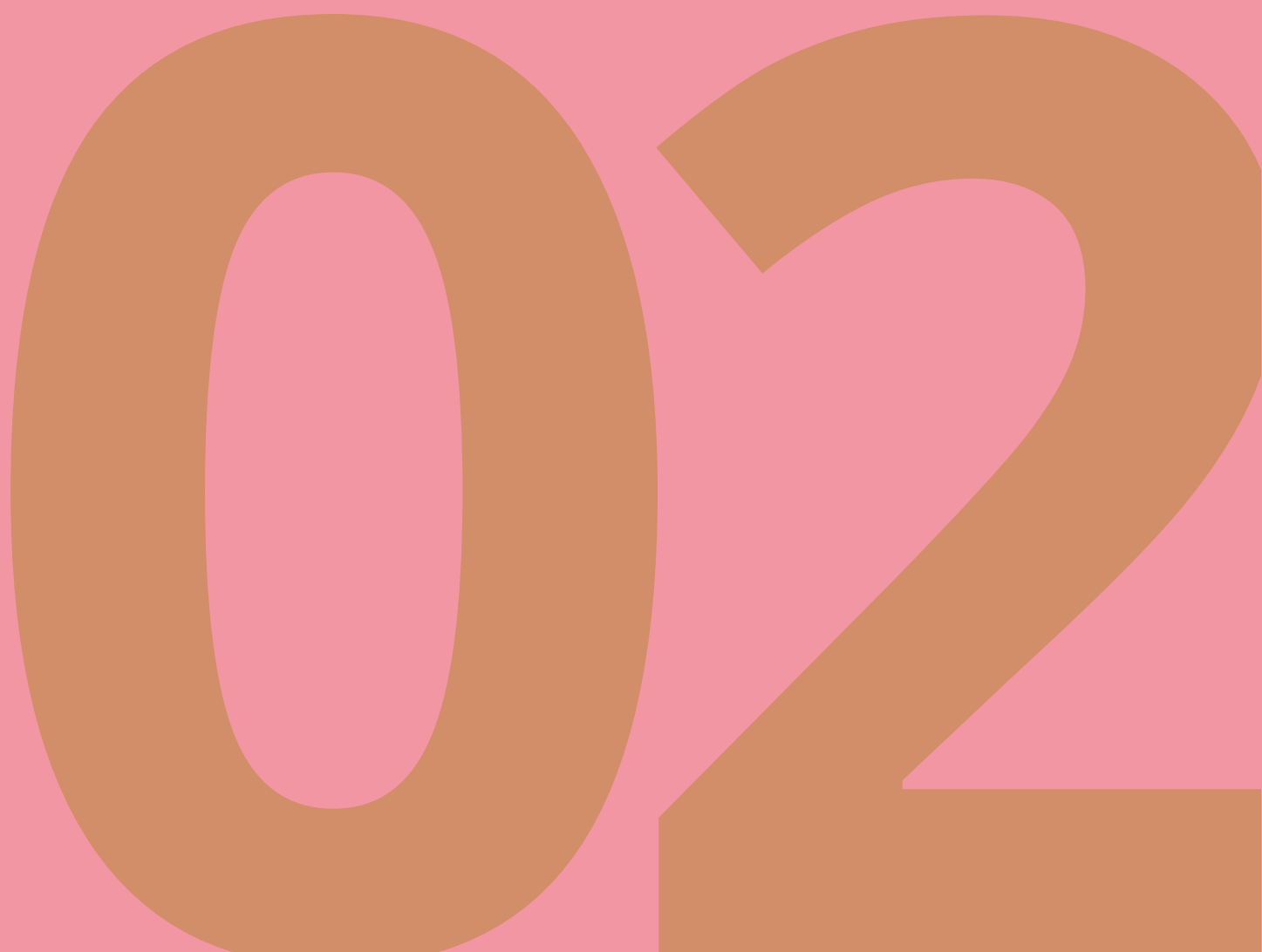
code.sprint^{MT} 2022 will be held in July 2022 as follows:

23 July: Award Ceremony (*Venue TBA*)



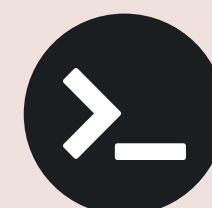
The aim of this contest

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Launched in 2018, code.sprint is a national coding contest that has become a yearly calendar event, originally designed for students studying Computing in secondary schools. It is now a coding championship widened to include challenges open to Computing secondary students, Computing/IT post-secondary students, undergraduate students. In this 5th edition, a category for already established software developers is also available.

The organisers are constantly exploring new ways to minimise the gap between education and industry, seeking to ensure that what students learn in schools / institutions is contextualised with what takes place in the workplace. Surely, code.sprint fulfills this in the most effective manner.

Indeed, the main objective of the initiative is to gauge participants' problem solving, computational and programming skills in an environment different than students are accustomed to in schools and during traditional exams. The challenge is a timed and an open book exercise, and the participants' work is adjudicated against a set of assessment criteria based on functionality and effectiveness.



AWARDS

The prizes for the top three code sprinters in each category include world-class study and mentorship programmes that further the candidates' programming skills, cash prizes and an awarding block-chained certificate / badge. All finalists earn cash vouchers and a 'Finalist' block-chained certificate / badge. All participants earn a block-chained certificate of participation.

Moreover, students within the secondary category can also achieve an MQF level-3 accreditation, issued by the Directorate for Quality and Standards in Education (DQSE).

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Entities should register their interest in sponsoring code.sprint^{MT} 2022 by compiling the online form on <https://forms.office.com/r/dCD4Sx5Ntz> by Monday, 14th February 2022.

Registered entities will be selected according to the criteria listed below. First criterion in list merits the highest preference and the last merits the least.



1. Entities related to software development and/or are registered software development houses.

2. Entities that contribute to the skilling/upskilling of digital expertise and the development of IT professions.

3. Entities related to the IT sector in general.

4. Entities with a CSR approach that promotes digital skills development.

5. Other entities.

In the event that more than one entity registers for the same sponsorship package and satisfies the same criterion/a, preference is given to the first registration entry.
